A RESOLUTION OF THE MACON-BIBB COUNTY COMMISSION APPOINTING WESTON STROUD TO SERVE AS A MEMBER OF THE MACON-BIBB COUNTY TRANSIT AUTHORITY; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Macon-Bibb County Transit Authority was established pursuant to 1980 Ga. Laws, p. 4313, § 1.1; and

WHEREAS, the composition and terms of membership for the Macon-Bibb County Transit Authority was amended pursuant to 1995 GA. Laws, Act 47, § 1; and

WHEREAS, the governing and administrative body of the authority consists of Board members appointed by the Mayor of Macon-Bibb County and said appointments are subject to approval by the Macon-Bibb County Commission; and

WHEREAS, members of the Board must be residents of Macon-Bibb County for the entire term of their appointment and shall be at least twenty-five (25) years of age; and

WHEREAS, each Board member serves for a term of five (5) years and is eligible for reappointment; and

WHEREAS, Weston Stroud has been recommended for appointment by Mayor Lester Miller to complete the unexpired term of Kenvoris Blair, who has resigned from the Board, and whose term is due to expire on January 5, 2030; and

WHEREAS, Weston Stroud has expressed his interest and willingness to serve on the Board, meets all requirements necessary for appointment and provided his resume and Certificate of Good Standing attached hereto as Exhibit A for reference and review; and

WHEREAS, the Macon-Bibb County Commission finds that this Resolution is necessary and proper to promote or protect the safety, health, peace, security, and general welfare of Macon-Bibb County and its inhabitants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Macon-Bibb County Commission, and it is hereby so resolved by the authority of the same, that Weston Stoud is hereby appointed to serve as a member of the Macon-Bibb County Transit Authority to complete the unexpired term of Kenvoris Blair, set to expire on January 5, 2030.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Macon-Bibb County Commission hereby declares that the foregoing preamble and whereas provisions set forth hereinabove constitute, and shall be considered to be, substantive provisions of this Resolution and are hereby incorporated by reference into this provision.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Macon-Bibb County Commission grants the Mayor the authority to take any and all further actions necessary to carry out the intents and purposes of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event scrivener's errors shall be discovered in this Resolution after the adoption hereof, the Macon-Bibb County Commission hereby authorizes and directs that each such scrivener's error shall be corrected in all multiple counterparts of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that except as specifically provided herein, any and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution shall be and the same hereby are repealed, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event that this Resolution or part thereof is found by any court of competent jurisdiction to be substantively more appropriately denominated an act of ordinance by the Macon-Bibb County Commission, it is the intent of this Commission that this Resolution or such portion thereof shall be considered to have been adopted as an ordinance of the Macon-Bibb County Commission. Where any law bearing on the subject matter of this Resolution calls for the taking of any legislative action by the governing authority of Macon-Bibb County, and such law specifies for such action to be taken by resolution or by ordinance, it is the intent of this Commission that this Resolution satisfy such requirement, and that this Resolution be construed accordingly. To the extent that this Resolution is construed by any appropriate authority as being substantively an act of ordinance and not an act of resolution, then this Resolution shall operate further to repeal all prior ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

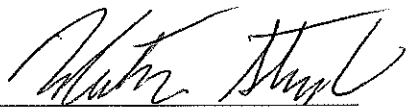

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MACON-BIBB COUNTY COMMISSION TO AUTHORIZE APPROPRIATIONS, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$24,754,403.03, FROM 2025 SPLOST BOND FUNDS TO PAVE THE WAY ROADS PROJECTS, THE JAIL EXPANSION AND RENOVATION PROJECT, THE ARENA PROJECT, AND VARIOUS PUBLIC SAFETY PROJECTS, AS SPECIFIED HEREIN; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, a one cent Special Purpose Local Option Sales and Use Tax was approved by Resolution R-24-0182 A, dated December 16, 2024, of the Macon-Bibb County Commission with a project list as described therein for capital outlay projects which was subsequently approved by the voters of the County on March 18, 2025 on all sales and uses within the County for an indefinite period of time, as allowed under the SPLOST Law for a consolidated government, (O.C.G.A. § 48-8-111.1), to be collected until the amount of specified tax has been raised, said total amount being \$450,000,000.00 which collection is set to begin on October 1, 2025, or upon the termination of the current SPLOST being collected (the “2025 SPLOST Revenues”); and

WHEREAS, in anticipation of the collection of the 2025 SPLOST Revenues, the Macon-Bibb County Commission authorized, via Resolution R-25-0128, dated August 2, 2025, the purchase of \$50,000,000.00 General Obligation Sales Tax Bonds (“2025 SPLOST Bond”) to be utilized to begin 2025 SPLOST projects and to be repaid from sales tax collections at a later time; and

WHEREAS, the Macon-Bibb County Commission, via Ordinance O-25-0044, dated September 23, 2025, adopted a budget for the expenditure of 2025 SPLOST Bond funds; and

WHEREAS, the Macon-Bibb County Commission believes that the appropriations included herein from 2025 SPLOST Bond funds, to provide funding for the planned expenditures

described herein, will benefit and be in the best interests of the citizens of Macon-Bibb County; and

WHEREAS, the Macon-Bibb County Commission finds that this Ordinance is necessary and proper to promote or protect the safety, health, peace, security, and general welfare of Macon-Bibb County and its inhabitants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Macon-Bibb County Commission and it is hereby so ordained by the authority of the same that:

Section 1

The Macon-Bibb County Commission does hereby approve and authorize the following transfers and appropriations for funding the following authorized expenditures, in the following amounts:

- A. \$20,000,000.00 from 2025 SPLOST – Roads – Contingency to 2025 SPLOST – Roads - Property to fund the Pave the Way roads projects;
- B. \$675,000.00 from 2025 SPLOST – Public Safety – Contingency to 2025 SPLOST – Public Safety – Sheriffs Buildings – Jail to fund architectural professional services;
- C. \$1,219,740.00 from 2025 SPLOST – Culture and Recreation – Contingency to 2025 SPLOST – Culture and Recreation – Arena to fund project management services;
- D. \$2,727,693.03 from 2025 SPLOST – Public Safety – Contingency to 2025 SPLOST – Public Safety – Other to fund the purchase of new tornado sirens; and
- E. \$122,970.00 from 2025 SPLOST – Public Safety – Contingency to 2025 SPLOST – Public Safety – Other to fund the purchase of weather radios.

Section 2.

The preamble of this Ordinance shall be considered to be and is hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set out herein.

Section 3.

The Mayor, the Finance Director, and all other proper officers and agents of the County are authorized and directed to execute such documents and to take such other actions as may be required to accomplish the intents and purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 4.

In the event scrivener's errors shall be discovered in this Ordinance or in the Exhibits hereto after the adoption hereof, the Commission hereby authorizes and directs that each such scrivener's error shall be corrected in all multiple counterparts of this Ordinance.

Section 5.

The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable, and not mutually dependent upon each other or upon any other provisions in the Macon-Bibb County Code of Ordinances. If any sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases of this Ordinance shall be declared illegal by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such illegality shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases of this Ordinance, or any other provisions of the Macon-Bibb County Code of Ordinances.

Section 6.

In the event that this Ordinance or part thereof is found by any court of competent jurisdiction to be substantively more appropriately denominated an act of resolution by the Macon-Bibb County Commission, it is the intent of this Commission that this Ordinance or such portion thereof shall be considered to have been adopted as a resolution of the Macon-Bibb County Commission. Where any law bearing on the subject matter of this Ordinance calls for the taking of any legislative action by the governing authority of Macon-Bibb County, and such law specifies for such action to be taken by resolution or by ordinance, it is the intent of this Commission that this Ordinance satisfy such requirement, and that this Ordinance be construed accordingly.

Section 7.

All ordinances or resolutions, or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 8.

Pursuant to and in accordance with Section 14 of the Charter, the Mayor may disapprove or reduce any item or items of appropriation in this Ordinance. The approved part or parts of this Ordinance making appropriations shall become law effective immediately upon its approval by the Mayor, and the part or parts disapproved shall not become law unless subsequently passed into law by the Commission over the Mayor's veto by the affirmative vote of six (6) members of the Macon-Bibb County Commission.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MACON-BIBB COUNTY COMMISSION TO AUTHORIZE THE APPLICATION FOR \$2,500,000.00 FROM THE GEORGIA OUTDOOR STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM (“GOSP”) AND ACCEPTANCE OF ANY AWARDED FUNDS FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE OCMULGEE HERITAGE TRAIL AND DEVELOPMENT OF CONSERVATION PARK; APPROPRIATING UP TO \$625,000.00 FROM 2018 SPLOST ROADS – OTHER, OCMULGEE HERITAGE TRAIL, TO BE USED AS A LOCAL MATCH FOR THE GOSP FUNDS; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Ocmulgee Heritage Trail (“OHT”) is a 12.5-mile greenway trail linking the Ocmulgee Mounds National Historical Park to Downtown Macon, Rose Hill Cemetery, and Amerson Park, acting as a connecting thread for visitors to enjoy a wide variety of cultural, ecological, and historical resources along the Ocmulgee River; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, the UDA acquired a 210-acre tract of real property adjacent to Amerson River Park from the Georgia Department of Transportation that is subject to restrictive covenants requiring the property to be used in a manner to promote wetland conservation (the “Property”); and

WHEREAS, Macon-Bibb County, in conjunction with the Macon-Bibb Urban Development Authority (“UDA”), desires to expand the OHT to provide access through the Property to provide space for recreation and education about the important wetland ecosystems along the Ocmulgee River, in a project dubbed “Conservation Park,”; and

WHEREAS, this expansion of the OHT falls directly in line with the mission of the Georgia Outdoor Stewardship Program (“GOSP”), a granting mechanism aimed at promoting parks and trails to protect and conserve lands critical to wildlife, clean water, and outdoor recreation across the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, currently, Amerson River Park, which lies immediately adjacent to the Property, hosts an average of 400,000 visitors annually; and

WHEREAS, the expansion of the OHT and additional amenities to be included in Conservation Park are expected to double the visitor capacity of Amerson River Park and provide an additional layer of experience where visitors can more closely observe and learn about the importance and impact of wetland ecosystems on water quality in the Ocmulgee River watershed; and

WHEREAS, the development of Conservation Park and the OHT extension are planned to include additional amenities, including one mile of expanded ADA accessible concrete trail, canoe launch and take-out spaces, additional parking and roads for access, restrooms, informational and educational kiosks and signage, three miles of natural trails, three miles of equestrian trails, environmental restoration efforts, and boardwalks for observation of the restored wetlands; and

WHEREAS, the costs associated with OHT trail expansion and development of Conservation Park are estimated at \$3,150,000.00; and

WHEREAS, to assist with funding this project, the Macon-Bibb County Commission desires to authorize the application for GOSP funds in the amount of \$2,500,000.00, and the acceptance of any such funds, if awarded; and

WHEREAS, the Macon-Bibb County Commission further desires to appropriate matching local funds in the amount of \$625,000.00 from 2018 SPLOST Roads – Other, Ocmulgee Heritage Trail to fund the balance of the expected cost of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Macon-Bibb County Commission finds that this Ordinance is necessary and proper to promote or protect the safety, health, peace, security, and general welfare of Macon-Bibb County and its inhabitants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Macon-Bibb County Commission and it is hereby so ordained by the authority of the same that:

Section 1

The Macon-Bibb County Commission hereby authorizes the application for GOSP funds in the amount of \$2,500,000.00, for the development of Conservation Park and the Ocmulgee Heritage Trail extension, and the acceptance of such funds, if awarded.

Section 2.

The Macon-Bibb County Commission hereby authorizes the appropriation of up to \$625,000.00 from 2018 SPLOST Roads – Other, Ocmulgee Heritage Trail as local matching funds for the development of Conservation Park and the Ocmulgee Heritage Trail extension, provided that Macon-Bibb County is awarded GOSP grant funds.

Section 3.

The preamble of this Ordinance shall be considered to be and is hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set out herein.
