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1. Approval of minutes from the August 27, 2019 meeting

ACTION

On motion of Commission Allen, seconded by Commissioner Wynn and carried unanimously, the minutes of the August 27, 2019 meeting were approved.

2. Update on the Subsequent Tax Sale and Business Licensing

Information

Wade McCord, Tax Commissioner, announced that during the recent subsequent tax sale, the revenue amounted to \$724,731. This does not include the people who came in and paid their taxes so their property could be removed from the sale.

Commissioner McCord presented his proposal to manage the Business License function of Macon-Bibb County. He stated that he would need an increase in his salary budget of \$202,716 which is \$14,000 less than what Business Development is currently paying. There would also be a one time cost of \$62,499 for computers, workstations, furniture and Tax Office Modifications. He continued that there may be transfer of other related operating line items such as postage, office supplied to the Tax Office Budget.

3. A Resolution Authorizing The Mayor To Negotiate With Management Advisory Group International, Inc For Professional Services To Include Conducting A Study Of Salary, Benefits, And Job Classification For Macon-Bibb County Not To Exceed \$150,000.00; And For Other Lawful Purposes. A Resolution adopting a Title VII Compliance Policy and Plan
