COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUNDS

Wanzina Jackson, Manager of ECD gave a presentation on Community Development Block Grants.

Subcommittee Reports

- **Policy and Legislation – Rachel Umana**

Rachel Umana reported on the Complete Streets Compliance Committee Meeting that was held prior to this meeting.

Commissioner Lucas provided an update on legislation regarding GDOT's approval to review speed reductions in the county. She also shared that the transit fee increase will not happen, thanks to MBC Government.

- **Engineering – Nigel Floyd**

Nigel Floyd reported that GDOT will review at least four locations for speed reduction. He has submitted three streets for speed reduction to the attorney office to prepare for commission review and approval.

Nigel Floyd also shared that speed zone cameras are being installed at elementary schools in Macon-Bibb County.

- **Enforcement – Lt. Scott Davis**

Lt. Davis stated the department is working on previous cases, he has no specific details that he can share right now.

- **Public Communications – Charise Stephens-Merriweather**

Greg Brown discussed the Open Streets Event along with the Easter Egg Hunt provided by Forrest Johnson. PSRB was present at both events.

- **Interagency Coordination**

There was no report.

Old Business

- **Crash360 Profile Report**

A representative from Crash360 was not available to attend this meeting.

- **Transportation Safety Manager's Position Update**

Adrianna Beaves reported that the funding is not complete and the organization chart needs updating.

On motion by Dr. Ficklin, seconded by Commissioner Lucas, and passed unanimously, to encourage Human Resources to prioritize this position and decide on compensation and job description to get it posted and ready for applicants to apply.

New Business

- **SS4A (Safe Streets for All) Grant Resubmission**

Greg Boike is working on the grant submission. It is due in July.
